- 5. Reading scripture in Dutch may lessen its impact.**



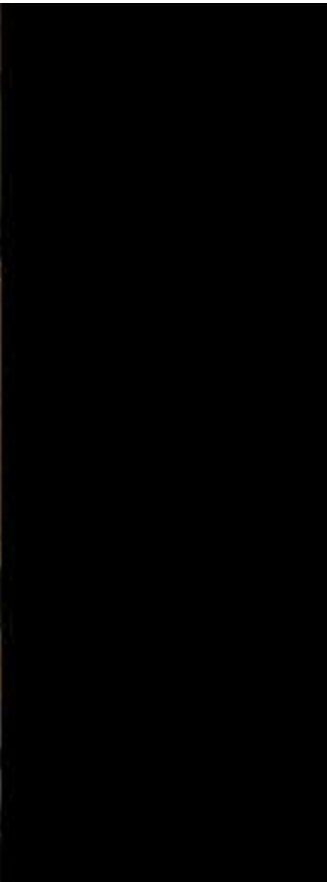
John 14:11–13 *Good News Translation*
